As West Virginia Public Theatre approaches the final weeks of 2023 and we look forward to 2024, WVPT board and staff thank you for your support and hope you will continue your valued contributions to the theatre's work. WVPT entertained and enriched the lives of over 7,000 West Virginians and visitors from neighboring states in 2023. Through live theatre productions, educational programs, and community outreach we brought joy, laughter, and thought-provoking stories to our audiences.

We know many students see live theatre for the first time when they attend WVPT school matinees. In December 2022, *Schoolhouse Rock, Live!* matinees drew over 2,000 school children from nine counties. WVPT expects over 4,000 students from eleven counties to see *Narnia: The Musical*.

Most recently, WVPT produced *The Mountaintop*, a fictional retelling of Martin Luther King Jr.'s last night, and *Sherlock Holmes: The Final Adventure*, a classic whodunit in Victorian London. Employing professional theatre actors, directors, and crews along with local talent, these productions attracted over 1,200 patrons.

In partnership with the acclaimed international company Broadway Licensing, WVPT produces annually a performance of a new musical in development. Past pieces include *Heartbreak Hotel*, *Ghost Brothers of Darkland County*, and *I Want to Know What Love Is*. Some of these pieces are being produced in professional theatres around the world.

This affiliation also includes a collaboration with the WVU School of Theatre & Dance, resulting in a WVPT production of an original work by the student winner of the Broadway Licensing Scholarship.
